New Leader 201 <i>Let's Lead!</i>	Start your journey as a new troop leader with all the right tools before you meet with your girls. Discover what being a Girl Scout leader is all about, Connect with the support available to you and Take Action to start your meetings with a new leader plan. Pre Requisite: Girl Scouting 101	3 hours Free	ALL volunteers leading girls
Trips & Travel 301 <i>Let's Go!</i> Available online	Prepare yourself and your Girl Scout troop to go beyond your regular meeting place including short day trips or overnight stays up to 2 nights away. All participants must complete knowledge check at the end to receive credit. Pre Requisites: 101 and 201	1 hour Free	Troops/groups taking their Girl Scouts outside of their regular meeting place. -Day trip to local zoo -Pajama party in home -Overnight travel
Extended Travel 302 <i>Let's Go Farther!</i> Available online	Prepare yourself and your Girl Scout troop to go beyond the short trips. Learn to plan with your troop to take them on a safe trip for 3 nights or more. All participants must complete knowledge check at the end to receive credit. Pre Requisites: 101, 201 and 301	1 hour Free	Troops taking their Girl Scouts on a trip of 2 nights or more
Outdoor Camping 401 <i>Let's Camp!</i> <i>Camping is defined as any activity in which Girl Scouts sleep overnight in the outdoors or in facilities at an established campground.</i>	Discover what you need to know to lead your Girl Scouts camping in the outdoors. Learn the eight basic skills for the outdoors including campfire safety, knot tying and more. Pre Requisites: 101, 201, 301, 302 <i>Basic Outdoor Camp Certification (BOCC) also qualifies for this requirement.</i>	8 hours \$35	Troops camping outdoors AND/OR Troops/groups cooking outdoors in a charcoal, propane established grill, wood or other fuels and methods.
<i>First Aid & CPR Certification</i>	Certification must be from the American Red Cross, National Safety Council, EMP America or the American Heart Association. Council may offer these opportunities as a convenience, please check our online calendar. Caution: First-aid/CPR training that is available entirely online does not satisfy Girl Scouts' requirements.	Varies in length and price	Troops going on any trip outside of their meeting place.
