Announcing a Big Change!

As of October 1, 2023, Girl Scouts Activity Accident Insurance Plan 2 is no longer in effect. What does this mean? This means that troops no longer need to purchase additional insurance to cover tagalongs or for trips that are three nights or longer. Plan 3P and 3PI remain optional for sickness plus accident coverage and international trips.

Please note that this change does not affect the adult-to-girl ratios, that must always be met, or the council troop trip approval process. All troops participating in an overnight activity must still submit Troop Trip & High-Risk Activity Form for council approval first. All adults participating in an overnight trip must be Girl Scout Volunteers: Girl Scout members with an approved background check on file.



Learning Moment - What are Service Units?

- Service Unit is the name for the geographic subdivisions of a council.
- A Service Unit Team consists of Girl Scout volunteers who work in close partnership with Council to manage their area.
- The Team serve as an intermediary between Council and Troops.
- Service Unit Positions include Manager, Treasurer, Communications, Registrar, Event Coordinator, Recruiter, Trainer, and Product Program positions to name a few.

 - Host events for girls to make friends and learn new skills.
 - Coordinate Fall Product and Cookie Programs.

A long-time Girl Scout tradition, the Quiet Sign is a great way to get your girls attention. When you want to quiet your troop, stop talking and raise your hand high with an open palm. As girls see your sign, they should also stop talking and raise their hand. Each finger represents a letter in the word QUIET. When the "hand goes up, the mouth goes shut." It's a great way to silence your group without shouting. Whether it's a room full of girls or at events with 200 plus adult participants, the Quiet Sign works like magic!

Troop/Service Unit Financial Reports




- If your Troop Financial Report is not turned in by November 30th, your troop will not participate in the council's Cookie Program.

<u>Renew Your Membership</u>



Minimum of five (5) girls and two (2) unrelated adults in leader and coleader roles to keep your troop in compliance.

Older Girl Scout troops (Cadettes, Seniors, Ambassadors) may have three girls only, if they are from at least two different families, and with council approval.

Council Properties

Council Property Building Rental / Usage

All property / building rentals and usage must follow the process below:

- Submit request to <u>info@gsdsw.org.</u>
- Complete the rental agreement and submit it to <u>info@gsdsw.org</u>.
- Once approved and placed on our property calendar you will receive an email with further instructions.
- No rental / usage of GSDSW properties / buildings are approved without going through the complete process.
- If you are found to be using GSDSW property / buildings without council approval all future rentals / usage will be denied.



- If you rent or use any of GSDSW's buildings, you are responsible for checking all areas to ensure they are clean.
- Be sure you are wiping tables down to remove crayon/glue/etc., sweeping or vacuuming, and make sure trash is put in the trash cans and clean recyclables are put in the recycling bins.
- Please make sure that there is no trash in the recycling bins.
- Painting and messy projects should be done over tile or outside. Do not do these projects on carpet or on chairs with fabric covers.
- Please check the restrooms to be sure toilets are flushed before you leave. It has been found that the toilets are not being flushed or are being stuffed with toilet paper.
- If after your rental or usage it is found that a cleaning crew or plumber needs to be brought in, you will be financially responsible and future usage will be denied.
