- Troop qualification must be verified with signatures from troop leader, girl troop members and your service unit manager (if applicable).
- Virtual activities may be substituted for in-person activities when available.

Applications received by the deadline and approved for eligibility, will be presented their award at the Ceremony of Honors in the same membership year submitted.

#### **Late Applications**

Honor Troop Applications submitted after the deadline of September 30, 2025. will be reviewed for eligibility and, if approved, presented at the Ceremony of Honors in the following membership year.
