The Honor Troop program serves as a guide for troops to ensure a well-rounded year of Girl Scouting. It allows your troop to successfully ensure girls are exposed to diverse, girl-led leadership opportunities. Please plan accordingly and integrate the requirements into your troop plans for the year.

- All requirements must be completed within 12 months or less (except Early Bird requirement).
- Troop qualification must be verified with signatures from troop leader, girl troop members and your service unit manager (if applicable).
- Virtual activities may be substituted for in-person activities when available.

Deadline

Completed applications (including all signatures) must be emailed to info@gdsw.org by October 1, 2024. Keep a copy for your records.

Applications received by the deadline and approved for eligibility, will be presented their award at the Ceremony of Honors in the same membership year submitted.

Late Applications

Honor Troop Applications submitted after the deadline of October 1, 2024. will be reviewed for eligibility and, if approved, presented at the Ceremony of Honors in the following membership year.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Requirements must be completed within a 12-month period or less (except Early Bird requirement).
2. **This is a troop program. At least 50% of the troop must participate in each activity, unless noted otherwise.**
3. Troops must complete all the mandatory requirements AND at least 20 additional activities in this packet.
4. Requirements and activities may be completed in any order.
5. One activity may NOT be used to fulfill more than one requirement. No double-dipping.
6. Virtual activities may be substituted for in-person activities when available.
7. **Honor Troop Applications are due October 1, 2024.**
8. Optional: Attach 3-5 pictures of your Honor Troop, with your application, to highlight if your application is approved.

MEMBERSHIP

- Renewal.** At least 70% of the girls and two adult volunteers* in the troop (as of March 31st) renew for the following Girl Scout year by June 30th.
 - Senior and Ambassador Troops.** If approved to have less than five Girl Scouts in the troop, ALL must renew.
 - Military.** For troops that meet at a military installation, at least 50% of the girls and two adult volunteers* must renew.
 - New Troops Starting after March 31st.** At least 70% of the girls and two adult volunteers* in the troop must renew by September 30th (on-time renewal).

- Retention.** Troop must maintain at least two adult volunteers* and five girls registered throughout the year. For troops with Senior and/or Ambassador Girl Scouts only, if less than five Girl Scouts in their troop, ALL must be retained.
