It allows your troop to successfully ensure girls are exposed to diverse, girl-led leadership opportunities. Please plan accordingly and integrate the requirements into your troop plans for the year.

- All requirements must be completed within 12 months or less (except Early Bird requirement).
- Troop qualification must be verified with signatures from troop leader, girl troop members and your service unit manager (if applicable).
- Virtual activities may be substituted for in-person activities when available.

#### **Deadline**

Completed applications (including all signatures) must be emailed to <a href="mailto:info@gsdsw.org">info@gsdsw.org</a> by October 1, 2024. Keep a copy for your records.

Applications received by the deadline and approved for eligibility, will be presented their award at the Ceremony of Honors in the same membership year submitted.

#### **Late Applications**

Honor Troop Applications submitted after the deadline of October 1, 2024. will be reviewed for eligibility and, if approved, presented at the Ceremony of Honors in the following membership year.
