## Gingerbread Man December 2025



As the end of the year approaches, there are a plethora of holidays that people around the world celebrate. Each one has its own traditions and ceremonies and iconic symbols. One of the more popular symbols of the wintertime holidays is the gingerbread house and gingerbread man.

The Gingerbread Man is a classic American folktale first published in 1875. It tells the story of a gingerbread cookle who magically comes to life and dashes out of the oven before anyone can take a bitel As he races through the countryside, he meets an evergrowing group of people and animals who all want to catch him, but he's just too fast.

Along the way he shouts his famous rhyme:
"Run, run, as fast as you can!
You can't catch me—I'm the Gingerbread Man!"

In the end, a clever fox tricks him into coming close, and the Gingerbread Man is eaten - reminding readers that not everyone who smiles is a friend.

Eating gingerbread is a tasty treat and those warm spices of the cookie make th winter a little less chilly. Especially dunking in a glass of milk or a cup of tea.

### **Big Congratulations to Troop 65904!**


