

Loss in the Girl Scout Community

We are absolutely heartbroken to share that members of our Girl Scouting community are among the victims of the Wednesday, January 29th plane crash. We are mourning this loss alongside the families, friends, and troops of those we've lost.

Alydia Livingston, an 11-year-old Girl Scout in Loudon County Troop 70202, as well as her sister Everly, who had been a member of Girl Scouts as well, and their parents, were onboard the regional jet. While we don't know all the details yet, we do know that Alydia and Everly were talented figure skaters who brought so much light to the world. We are in contact with the affected troops and have offered our support in navigating this terrible tragedy.

This news has shaken us to our cores. We know it may feel impossible to digest. While we can't understand such tragedies, we will hold each other in light during this difficult time.

2026 Girl Scout Convention July 20–25, 2026

Join us (and 10,000+ Girl Scouts) at the 2026 Girl Scout Convention in Washington, DC, as we celebrate the spirit, individuality, and self-confidence that make Girl Scouts shine.

This special six-day gathering only happens once every three years and will take place at the Walter E. Washington Convention Center. Convention kicks off with our 58th National Council Session (NCS) from July 20–22, where delegates from around the country and overseas gather to vote on and discuss issues important to our Movement, and elect leaders for the next triennium.

After NCS, from July 23–25, thousands more Girl Scouts (and alums, families, and non-members) stream into town for a multi-day event featuring interactive workshops, inspiring speakers, and once-in-a- lifetime adventures that spark forever friendships.


