Now through Thursday, July 31, 2025, all new girl and adult members who register can receive \$10 off using the discount codes below. These codes are only valid for new members and cannot be used by existing or renewing members.

Girl Scout New Registration

Extended Year

For the 2026 membership year (October 1, 2025 – September 30, 2026), Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) has set the annual national membership dues at:

\$45 for girl members\$30 for adult members

Extended Year Membership (April 1 – July 31, 2025) New members who join during this time can opt into the Extended Year Membership, which covers both the remainder of the current year and the full following membership year. The standard dues for this option are:

\$63 for girls\$42 for adults

However, as a one-time offer to help offset rising costs, new members signing up during the Extended Year window will receive a \$10 discount on their membership. This means:

> Girls pay \$53 instead of \$63 Adults pay \$32 instead of \$42

This discount is only available to new members and is meant to provide a little financial relief as prices rise across many areas of life.
